Claim procedure

- 1. Claims for low-income senior citizens/disabled discounts shall be reflected on the utility bill following application and eligibility for directly billed customers.
- 2. Indirectly billed customer's eligible for the low-income senior citizen/disabled discount shall be filed between **January 3nd** and **February 28 or 29th** of the year **following** the period for which the discount is claimed.

Eligibility

The dwelling unit:

- a. Must be occupied by the person claiming the discount;
- b. Claimant must be head of the household;
- c. Utility account must be kept current; and
- d. No person may claim a discount for more than one dwelling unit during the same period.

The <u>claimant</u> must qualify in one of the following two categories throughout the period for which the discount is claimed:

1. Low-income senior citizen.

- a. At least 62 years of age; and
- b. Total household income of thirty thousand dollars or less.

OR

- 2. Low-income disabled: Household income is at or below one hundred twenty-five percent of the federally established poverty level* and claimant:
 - a. Qualifies for special parking as defined by RCW 46.16.381; or
 - b. Is blind as defined by RCW 74.18.020; or
 - c. Is disabled, handicapped or incapacitated as defined by any other existing state or federal program.

*2012 Federal Poverty Level (125% HHS Guidelines):

Income Defined by RCW 84.36.383 (5)

Adjusted gross income as defined in the federal internal revenue code, as amended prior to January 1, 1989, plus all of the following items to the extent they are not included in or have been deducted from adjusted gross income:

- a. Capital gains;
- b. Amounts deducted for loss;
- c. Amounts deducted for depreciation;
- d. Pension and annuity receipts;
- e. Military pay and benefits other than attendant-care and medical-aid payments;
- f. Veterans benefits other than attendant-care and medical-aid payments;
- g. Federal social security act and railroad retirement benefits;
- h. Dividend receipts; and
- i. Interest received on state and municipal bonds
