Notice is hereby given that on September 9, 2016 an application was made to the City requesting approval of the following: Request for a shoreline substantial development permit approval and SEPA review for the following project: The City of Marysville plans to complete a remedial action to place a minimum 6" cap to isolate the bulk of contaminants from the benthic macro-invertebrates that inhabit surface sediments within the marina's lagoon. The cap will be composed of clean sandy material and will cover the entire lagoon bottom to isolate contaminants and promote recovery. The environmental remedial action will mitigate the potential for future impact to human health and the environment by addressing site contaminants that exceed associated Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA) cleanup levels for unrestricted land use. According to the SEPA checklist approximately 10,104 cubic yards of material will be required to cap the lagoon.
