



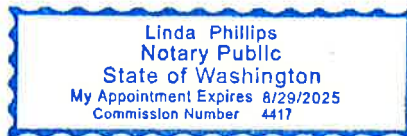



NOTICE OF APPLICATION

Notice is hereby given that on March 31, 2023 an application was made to the City of Marysville requesting modification of the existing drive-thru to accommodate a second lane and to reconfigure the drive-thru and parking configuration. In order to accommodate the second drive-thru lane the applicant has requested variances to reduce on-site parking from 56 to 41 stalls, reduce the 15' L3 landscape buffer along 88th Street NE to approximately 7' and reduce the 15' L2 landscape buffer adjacent to I-5 to approximately 9'. The variance will require a public hearing before the Hearing Examiner.
