


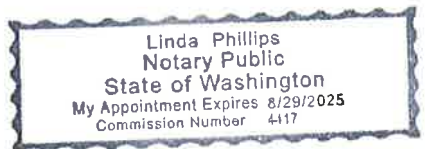

Notice is hereby given that on March 7, 2022 an application was made to the City of Marysville Community Development Department requesting State Environmental Policy Act Review for a proposed road widening project along State Avenue from 104th Street NE to 116th Street NE. The project includes expanding the roadway corridor capacity from 3-lanes to 5-lanes to improve operations, constructing sidewalks on the east side of State Avenue to provide safety and non-motorized access, replacement of water main within the project limits, upgrading stormwater systems for conveyance and treatment, revisions to luminaire design to improve lighting along the corridor and coordination with franchise utilities to relocate underground where possible.
