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"CHECKLIST"

PRIOR TO SUBMITTING THIS APPLICATION TO THE CITY OF MARYSVILLE FOR A DEMOLITION OF YOUR PROJECT YOU MUST CHECK WITH THE FOLLOWING AGENCIES

- Puget Sound Air pollution control agency permit must be submitted and obtained before city demolition permit can be issued.
- Check with the City of Marysville Utility Billing office for any outstanding accounts.
 Any utility fees must be paid prior to permit issuance.

Contractors must have a City of Marysville Business License to do work inside the City limits and they will need an active license from the State Department of Labor & Industries.

- City of Marysville Business License can be obtained on line at: www.dol.wa.gov
- State Department of Labor & Industries can be contacted at their Everett Office at: 425-290-1300
- Licenses will be checked and must be current prior to permit issuance.

APPLICATION SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Application
- 2. Puget Sound Clean Air permit number on application
- 3. Asbestos survey attached

MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION:

- 1. Application for city demolition permit must be completed and submitted at least 7 to 10 days prior to demolition.
- 2. Building official and construction foreman will review the site prior to any demolition work.
- 3. Applicant will be notified by the building department when the demolition permit is ready for issuance.
- 4. City will pull water meter.
- 5. Contractor to cap and mark sewer stub.
- 6. Check with Utility Billing for any outstanding water/sewer fees due.

Please contact the Marysville Historical Society at <u>marysvillehistoricalsociety@verizon.net</u> prior to demolition of any structure older than 50 years.

An incomplete application could delay your permit.
