PLAN REVIEW

- Residential review (includes duplexes):
 - Separate electrical plans for residential construction are exempt and are not required for review.
- Commercial & Multi-family (triplex and over):
 - o 2 complete sets of electrical plans are required for review.
 - o Under 100 amps and/or under 2,500 sq. ft. are exempt for plan submittal and review.

Residential (Single-Family or Duplex) Fees

New construction, additions, or remodels are based on size of project.

Under 1,000 square feet	\$100.00
1,001 to 2,000 square feet	\$150.00
2,001 to 3,000 square feet	\$200.00
3,001 square feet and over	\$250.00
Garages and outbuildings (stand-alone projects)	\$100.00
Service/panel change or alteration	\$ 75.00
Circuits added/altered without service change	
1 or 2 circuits	\$ 50.00
3 or more circuits	\$ 75.00
Meter/mast repair or alteration	\$ 75.00
