Project Description: Application for Administrative Site Plan approval with State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) Review. The applicant is seeking approval to construct a 58-unit Multi-family development and associated improvements on 4.99 acres.
SEPA Threshold Determination: The lead agency has determined that this proposal does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is NOT required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). Any appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$500.00, and be filed in writing at the City of Marysville Community Development Department, 501 Delta Avenue, Marysville, WA 98270.
