SUMMARY:

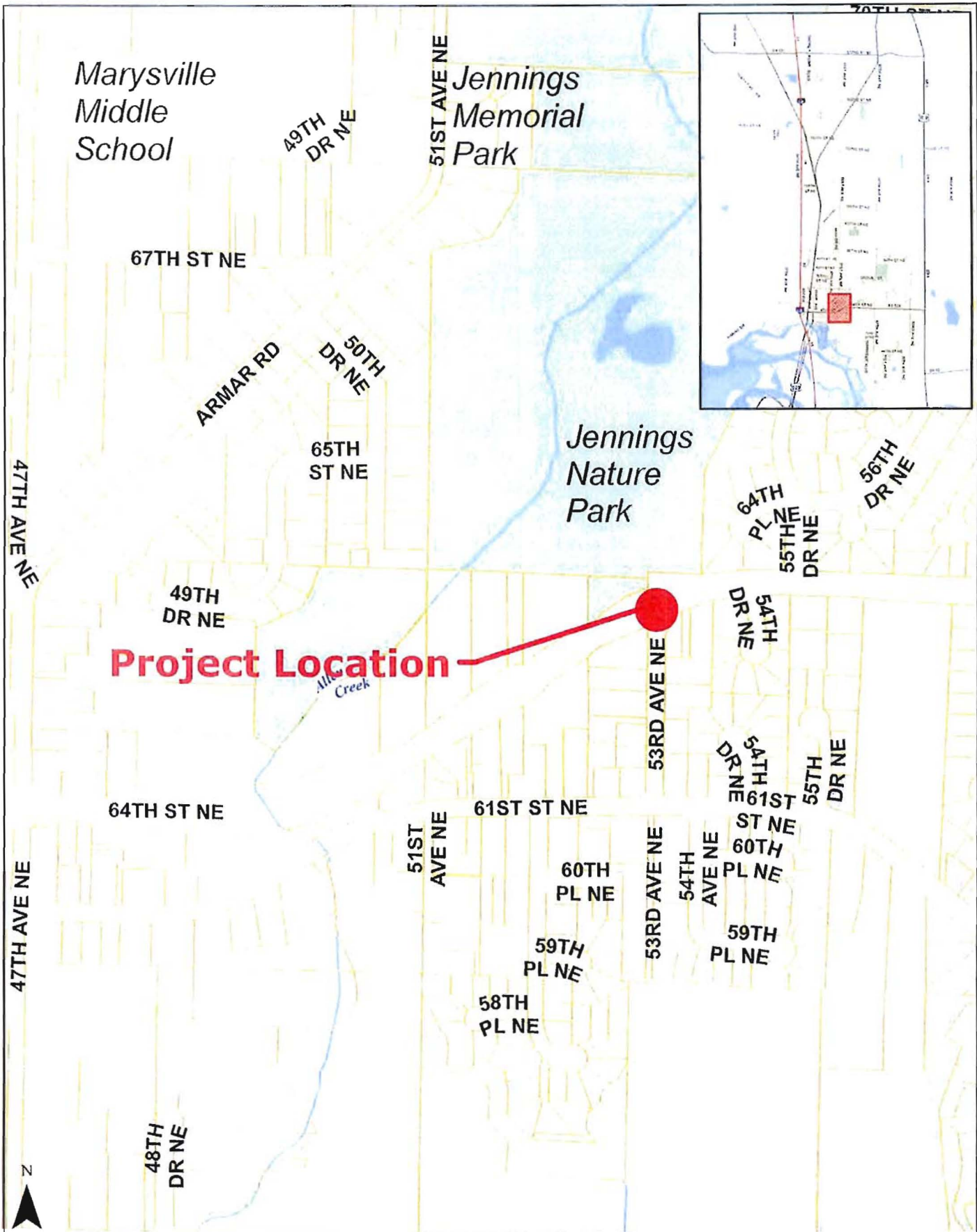
The City was awarded \$225,000 in federal funding for the 53rd Ave NE and SR 528 Intersection Improvements project to construct a new traffic signal at the intersection and modify the entry into Jennings's Park.

The project was advertised for an August 29, 2013 bid opening. The City received X bids as shown on the attached bid tabulation. The low bidder was X at \$X. The engineer's estimate is \$265,000.00. References have been checked and found to be satisfactory.
