SUMMARY:

The Washington State Department of Transportation has declared certain properties as surplus along SR528. The City identified the property south of SR528 and north of Sunnyside Blvd, tax parcel 30053300202400 as necessary for transportation purposes (future widening of Sunnyside Blvd). As a result, WSDOT is able to transfer the property to the City at no charge.

QUITCLAIM DEED

SR 528, Jct. SR 5 in Marysville to Jct. SR 9

The STATE OF WASHINGTON acting by and through its DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, Grantor, for and in consideration of CONTINUED ROAD USE PURPOSES, hereby conveys and quitclaims unto the CITY OF MARYSVILLE, a municipal corporation, Grantee, all right, title, and interest in and to the following described real property situated in Snohomish County, State of Washington:

All that portion of the hereinafter described PARCEL "A" lying Southeasterly of following described line:

Beginning at a point opposite Highway Engineer's Station (hereinafter referred to as HES) 74+50 of the SR 528 line survey of SR 528, Jct. SR 5 in Marysville to Jct. SR 9 and 80 feet Southerly therefrom; thence Northeasterly parallel to said line survey to a point opposite HES 76+50 of said line survey; thence Northeasterly to a point opposite HES 77+00 and 60 feet

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Southerly therefrom; thence Northeasterly parallel to said line survey to a point opposite HES 79+00 and the end of this line description.

PARCEL "A"

That property described in Warranty Deed executed by Grace H. Collingwood, Robert H. Burns and I. Nancy Burns, dated July 10, 1972, recorded October 2 1972 in Volume 634 of Deed, Page 525 under Auditor's File No. 2265748 (Tract 1) and Warranty Deed executed by Grace H. Collingwood, dated November 16, 1973, recorded January 31, 1974 in Volume 751 of Deeds, Page 348 under Auditor's File No. 2327463 (Tract 2) records of Snohomish County, Washington:

Tract 1

Commencing at the intersection of the East line of Section 28, Township 30 North, Range 5 East, W.M., and the center of Allen Creek, and running thence South on the said East line of said Section 28 to the North boundary line of the Marysville-Snohomish pave highway; thence Westerly along the North boundary line of said highway to the center If Allen Creek; thence Northeasterly along the center of Allen Creek to the place of beginning, LESS AND EXCEPT the East 200 feet of said tract situate in the County of Snohomish, State of Washington.

Tract 2

The West 55 feet of the East 200 feet of the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 28, Township 30 North, Range 5 East, W.M., lying Southerly of the centerline of Allen Creek and Northerly of the Marysville-Snohomish paved highway; all situate in the County of Snohomish, State of Washington.

EXCEPT, Grantor reserves to itself and its successors and/or assigns, all easement rights of access, light, view and/or air in the property herein conveyed to the extent that the property abuts the state highway right of way; therefore, the Grantee herein, including successors or assigns, shall have no right of ingress or egress to, from or between SR 528 and the lands herein described, nor shall Grantee, its successors or assigns, be entitled to compensation for any loss of access, light, view and/or air occasioned by the location, construction, reconstruction, maintenance or operation of said highway.

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The specific details concerning all of which may be found on sheet 4 of 8 sheets of that certain plan entitled SR 528, Jct. SR 5 in Marysville to Jct. SR 9, now of record and on file in the office of the Secretary of Transportation at Olympia, Washington, bearing date of approval August 6, 1970, revised September 26, 2014.

Subject to all existing encumbrances, including easements, restrictions and reservations, if any.

The Grantee, on behalf of itself and successors or assigns, as part consideration made herein, waives and/or releases Grantor from any past, present, or future claims for damages directly or indirectly caused by highway drainage or runoff, and further, Grantee, its successors or assigns, shall have no right of compensation for damages to the property herein conveyed caused directly or indirectly by highway drainage or runoff.

The Grantee herein, on behalf of itself and its successors or assigns, covenants and agrees that the above referenced property is transferred for road/street purposes only, and no other use shall be allowed. Should said property cease to be used for road/street purposes said ownership shall automatically revert to Grantor, and Grantee, its successors or assigns, agree to convey by deed the property to Grantor immediately upon Grantor's written notice to Grantee, its successors or assigns. Further, Grantee, its successors or assigns, shall release in the deed all Grantee's successors', or assigns' interest in said property.

The herein described property abuts SR 528 and currently has no legally permitted approaches or driveways to said highway.

The Grantee, on behalf of itself and its successors or assigns, as part consideration herein, does hereby agree to comply with all civil rights and anti-discrimination requirements of chapter 49.60 RCW as to the lands herein conveyed.

The lands herein described are not required for state highway purposes and are conveyed pursuant to the provisions of RCW 47.12.080.

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
