<p>The work of this contract involves the construction of pedestrian and bicycle improvements on 116th St NE from east of State Avenue to east of 47th Ave NE and near Marshall Elementary School. The work includes site preparation, storm drainage facilities, curb, gutter and sidewalk, grading, pavement cutting, paving, striping, signage and property restoration.</p> <p>The project is funded in part by the WSDOT Safe Routes to School Program.</p> <p>The project was advertised for a May 25, 2017 bid opening. The City received X bids. The low bidder was X at \$X. The engineer's estimate is \$517,835.70. References have been checked and found to be satisfactory.</p>
