| SUMMARY: <br> The work of this contract involves the construction of pedestrian and bicycle improvements on $116^{\text {th }}$ St NE from east of State Avenue to east of $47^{\text {th }}$ Ave NE and near Marshall Elementary School. The work includes site preparation, storm drainage facilities, curb, gutter and sidewalk, grading, pavement cutting, paving, striping, signage and property restoration. |  |
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| The project is funded in part by the WSDOT Safe Routes to School Program. |  |
| The project was advertised for a May 25,2017 bid opening. The City received 2 bids. The low bidder was SRV Construction, Inc. at $\$ 517,878.20$. The engineer's estimate is $\$ 517,773.70$. References have been checked and found to be satisfactory. |  |
