SUMMARY:	
The Decant Facility Addition project allowed for the construction of a new 44x26 foot additional bay onto the existing decant facility. The project is funded in part by a Department of Ecology Stormwater Grant, which Council authorized on December 14, 2015. Ecology covered 75% of the cost of construction.  City Council awarded the project to Road Construction Northwest, Inc. on November 13, 2017 in the amount of \$339,402.12 including a management reserve of \$30,000.00. The project was	
completed at a cost of \$313,139.31, which was, \$3,737.19 over the original bid amount but within management reserve.	
Work performed under this contract was inspected by City staff and found to be physically complete in accordance with the approved plans and specifications.

Ecology Stormwater Grant (75%): Total Cost to the City (remaining 25%):	(\$234,854.48) \$78,284.83

## RECOMMENDED ACTION:
