Declaring May 15-21, 2022, Emergency Medical Services Week in Marysville

WHEREAS, access to quality emergency care dramatically improves the survival and recovery rate of those who experience sudden illness or injury and is a vital public service; and

WHEREAS, Marysville Fire District emergency medical technicians and paramedics are ready to provide lifesaving care to those in need 24 hours a day, seven days a week; and

WHEREAS, emergency medical service has grown to fill a gap by providing important out-of-hospital care including preventative medicine, follow-up care and access to telemedicine; and

WHEREAS, the emergency medical services system consists of first responders, emergency medical technicians, paramedics, emergency medical dispatchers, firefighters, police officers, educators, administrators, pre-hospital nurses, emergency nurses, emergency physicians, trained members of the public, and other out-of-hospital medical care providers; and

WHEREAS, members of emergency medical services teams engage in thousands of hours of specialized training and continuing education to enhance their lifesaving skills; and

WHEREAS, we recognize the value and the accomplishments of emergency medical services providers by designating Emergency Medical Services Week;
