Declaring July 2022 Parks and Recreation Month in Marysville

- WHEREAS, our parks and natural recreation areas ensure the ecological beauty of our community and provide a place for children and adults to connect with nature and recreate outdoors; and

NOW, THEREFORE I, JON NEHRING, MAYOR, do hereby proclaim July 2022 as
