
NOTICE OF APPLICATION & OPTIONAL DNS PROCESS

The proposed project is located on Grove Street, between State Ave and Cedar Ave within public right-of-way. The applicant is proposing to grind and pave within the existing roadway prism of Grove Street in order to construct new sidewalk and new channelization for bicycle lanes. Also included in the project are necessary storm drainage improvements to collect and convey storm water runoff. The applicant will also be replacing a portion of the existing cast iron water main with ductile iron pipe. There are no critical areas on or within 500' of the project site. The applicant will use best management practices during construction and restore any property impacted to its original condition prior to project construction.

Notice is hereby given that the City of Marysville, being the lead agency for the following project, expects to issue a DNS for this proposal utilizing the Optional DNS process outlined in WAC 197-11-355:
